In general Speedboard are committed to reducing energy use per unit of product shipped. Recent examples include:-

- Lagging of heating and cooling duct work
- Ongoing replacement of lights to low power lights
- Replacement compressor via Carbon Trust for a new super efficient model. Including re-cycling of the waste heat to warm the factory

Although not accredited to ISO16001 we work towards achieving its objectives.
