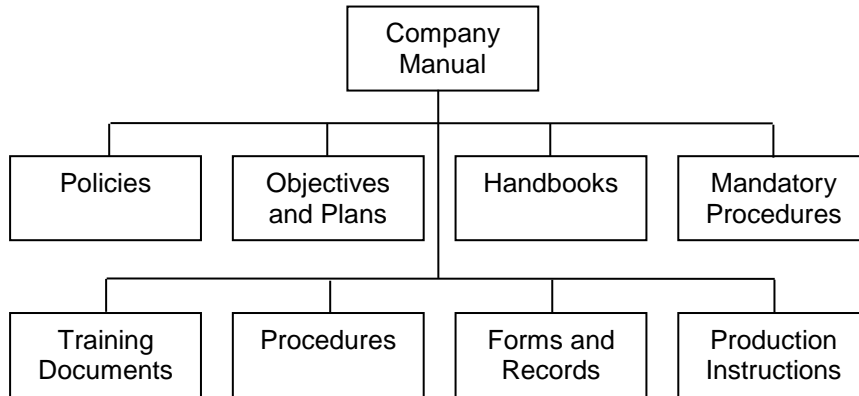
Plans and Objectives...

The plans and objectives are reviewed formally at management reviews and additionally as often as the business dictates. An up to date copy can be found on our main notice boards.

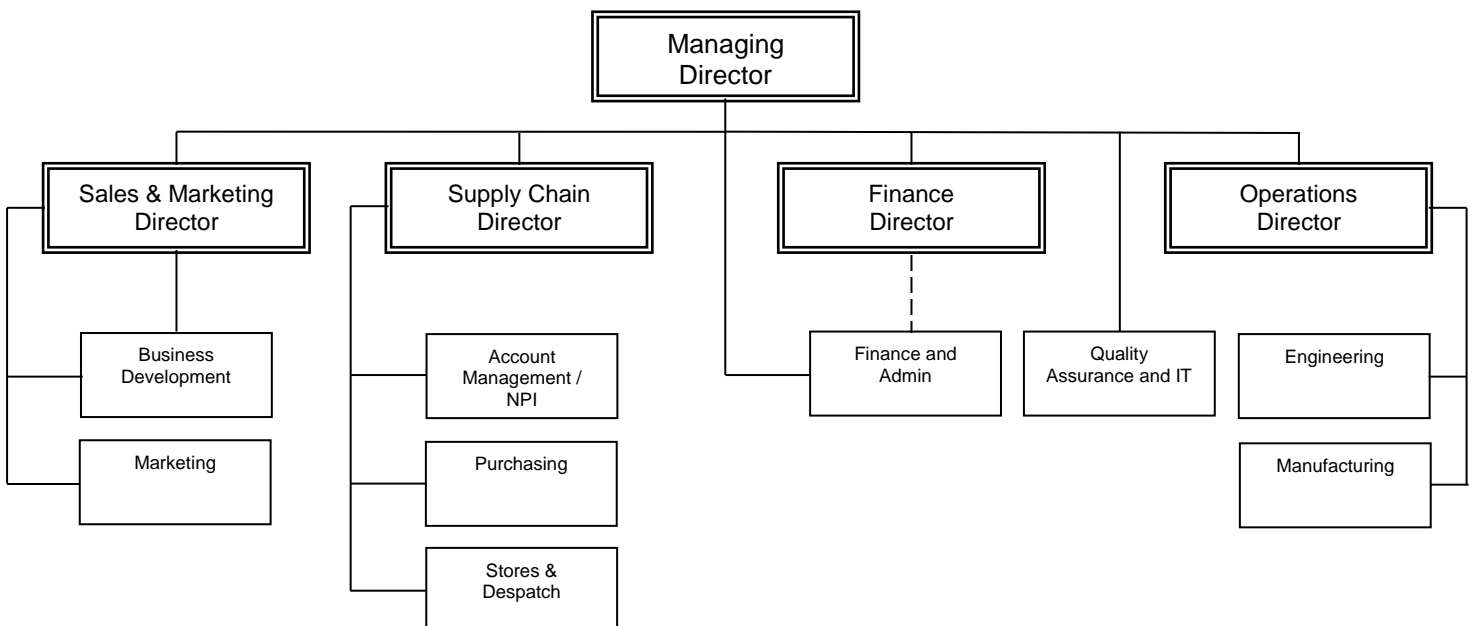

The following chart depicts the hierarchy of our IMS. A full list of all documents is available on the company's intranet site.



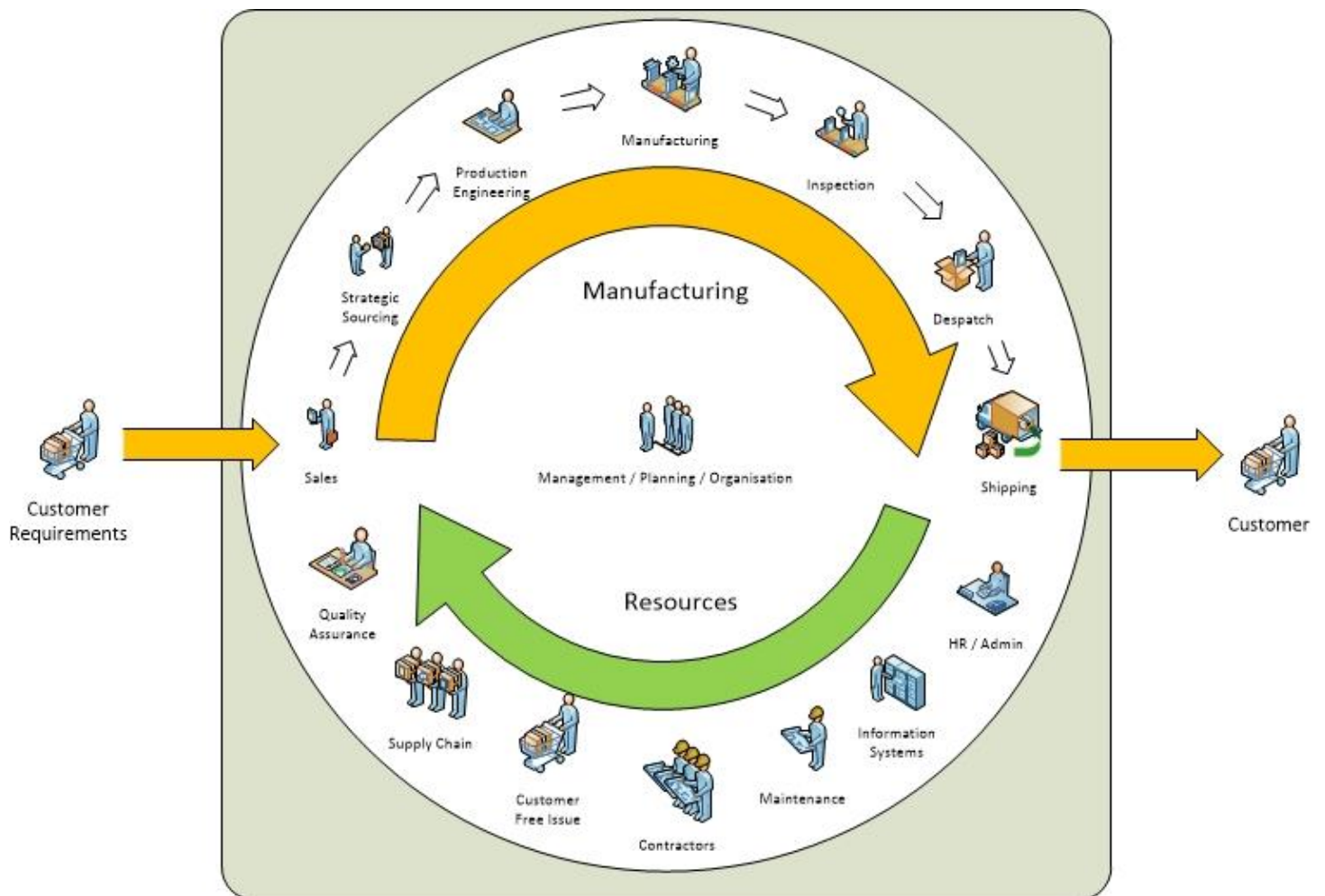
Organisation...

The following chart depicts the hierarchy of our management team. A full organisation chart is available on the notice boards and intranet.




Interaction...
